What we do

School Council helps to empower pupils, helps them to develop crucial skills for their future and improve our school community.

School Council have an active part and voice in the decision making and future of the school.

How we do it

We took 5 steps to ensure School Council is effective and productive:

- 1. Set up a progress board on the School Council noticeboard to show our projects and priorities, and who is responsible.
 - 2. Create a pupil SEF group, to produce a Pupil Self Evaluation document and present to SLT and governors.
 - 3. Set up regular, pupil-led groups to engage more pupils in activity.
 - 4. Encourage pupils to set up Action Teams for each priority in the Pupil SEF. Give more pupils the opportunity to lead.
 - 5. Regular fortnightly meetings to ensure continuity and regular involvement in whole school events and developments.
