



## PE Sport Premium 2016/2017

## **Fund Allocation**

The Sport Premium received by Forty Hill C of E Primary School in 2016/17 is **£9035**. Below is the suggested allocation of funds and the intended impact that this funding will have for the school.

PE/SPORTS premium spending	Fund allocated (Estimated allocation)	Intended impact
Additional Teaching staff (Mrs Stacey Wed/Fri)	£2500	Children in Year 2 – Year 6 will receive greater quality provision from a qualified PE coach
Contribution Towards Swimming Lessons at Albany Pool	£2000	The children will swim at a local swimming pool for a term and a half, promoting swimming skills and healthy, active lifestyles. Due to having two year 6 classes, we feel that subsidising some of the cost with the Sport Premium will allow us to continue to spend money in other academic areas across the school.
Replenish playground and PE resources	£635	Replenishing and adding equipment to the outdoor playtime equipment as well as PE equipment will enable a greater range of activities to take place and encourage children to be more responsible for the equipment purchased for them.
Purchase new team kits for Netball and Football	£600	School kit will continue to give the children a sense of pride when competing for the school.
Hire Athletics Stadium for Sports Day (QE Stadium or Lee Valley)	£500	Hiring the Athletics Centre for our Sports Day will provide all children with a sense of achievement and pride as they compete and take part in skills games.
Offer good quality lunchtime football sessions to promote positive behaviour (Pro Direct Football Club)	£300 12 x 30 minute lunchtime sessions @ £25 per session	Children to be rewarded with football sessions for good behaviour and concentration in the lead up to, and after, SATs tests. Children to benefit from team values and understand the importance of fair play.
Competition and Celebrations as well as holding intra-sport competitions throughout the year	£600 to include cost of sports companies and medals/trophies	Use a Sports Company to hold intra-sport competitions for all children to participate in a range of sports as well as provide medals and trophies to celebrate sporting success.
Enfield PE service, "Excellence in PE Programme"	£1900	The Enfield PE team provide CPD opportunities for staff to observe excellent practitioners teach children. This is useful training for our staff. They also organise events, league clusters, PE subject leader meetings and other useful information for the school.
Total	£9035	Forty Hill C of E Primary School will continue to provide quality PE provision and sporting opportunities for all children within the school.
