<p>PE</p>	<div style="background-color: #f08080; padding: 10px;"> <p>Stickman  Get Set 4 PE</p> <p>What you need: A pen and piece of paper, one player, one person to choose the words.</p> <p>How to play:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One person (the word master) chooses a word and draws lines on the paper, one for each letter. • The player guesses a letter that could be in the word. If they are correct the word master writes the letter on the correct line. • If the named letter is not in the word the word master draws part of a stickman and the player must complete 10 of one of the below exercises: star jumps / hops / sit ups / jumping twists / press ups • Can the player guess the word before the word master draws a complete stickman? • NB, stickman to include head, body, two arms and two legs <p style="text-align: center;">  </p> </div>
